Some of them stay with foster families while about 50 kids live in the premises of the orphanage. There are three dormitories and a common room that is used for homework and playing. There are about 15 staff currently employed.

Brief description and main aims

The Salvation Army Rehabilitation Centre is a Medical Centre that Provides Physiotherapies and rehabilitation Service to Children and Adults. They also go on outreach and provide general Health Care at the Community Levels.

The aim and priority of the center is to provide support for the physically challenged in the society especially;

1. The poor who is economically disadvantaged and whose access to other sources of health care is restricted.
 2. Children, Treatment performed early on a child life is often more effective.
- The ultimate aim in assisting children with impairments is to facilitate their inclusion in education.

This priority does not exclude treatments of some adults.

Main Activities

The centre assists and support persons with disabilities especially children and vulnerable adults through

- physiotherapy services
- providing assistive devices like canes, crutches, walkers, wheelchairs etc.
- support to undergo surgeries and
- Counselling and psychosocial support

Volunteer Tasks

- Assisting the clinical staff in providing physiotherapy and rehab services
- Assist those in the Centre in their daily task
- Go on outreach programmes to provide general health care and Rehab services at the community level
- Help in the Clinic by doing administrative/Secretariat job

Brief description and main activities

The mission of Achiaa Greenlight School is to provide formal education, produce future leaders and contribute to the shaping of Children in Ghana. The school has about 700 students and over 50 employees. It admits children who are between the ages of 2 to 16 years into their daycare, primary and junior high school departments.

Volunteer tasks

The school will like Volunteers to assist the teachers in performing their duties. Some of the duties include:

- 🚩 Planning of the course content
- 🚩 Taking care of the Children
- 🚩 Providing support to children who need special attention in some subjects.

Volunteer Requirements / Skills

🚩 Name of Project: **NATION BUILDERS SCHOOL AND ORPHANAGE**



It is a NGO founded after charity motivation. It hosts 17 orphans and half-orphans, from which some were picked up from the streets. The so-called half-orphans have one living parent, who cannot provide even for him/herself, so they rather give it to the care of the orphanage. That is how the children receive a home, regular nutrition and health care.

Main Activities

The day begins with the kids getting ready for their school and ends when they go to bed at night. The orphanage provides education, food, leisure activities and anything else that the children might need.

Volunteer tasks

To support the "House Mother", teach in the school, take care of the children, assisting mother at the market. To help in the kitchen, help the children with their homework, help wash clothes, play with the children, organise leisure activities (sport competitions).

Any extra knowledge that the volunteer can teach or any activity they want to develop is accepted (after approval of the staff).

Brief description and main aims

Royal school Complex Is located in Breman Kuntanase in the Asikuma-Odoben-Brakwa district in the central region of Ghana. The school provides affordable basic education to the children in the community and admits from nursery to primary 6. The population of the school is 332.

Volunteer Tasks

- Supporting Teachers in class room
- Taking care of children during break time
- Helping Children to eat especially the little ones who cannot feed themselves
- Engaging the children in their extra co-curricular activities

Volunteer Requirements / Skills

The volunteer should be someone who can speak, read, write and understand English language. The volunteer can be of any gender and must be 18 years and above.

Location/Community

Breman Kuntanase is the fourth biggest town in the district of Asikuma-Odoben-Brakwa. It has a population of eleven thousand peoples. The name of the festival of the community is Aboakyire meaning hunting of wild animal. The people in the community are predominantly peasant farmers with few formal sector workers and petty traders. Their main source of fuel for cooking is firewood. About 95% of the entire community population uses firewood in cooking. The people are friendly and very hospitable. Many kinds of foods such as fufu, red red, konkonte, banku, fante kenkey, aprerensa, and many more.

Hosting

Volunteers will be living with a host family in the community. Volunteers should also bear in mind that they will be sharing a room with other volunteers.
