背景

The city of Saint-Cyr-en-Val welcomes you in the south of the Loire, twenty minutes by public transport and bicycle away from downtown Orleans.

In 2019, Orleans Metropole and its member municipalities have decided to work together on joint projects in the field of international mobility for young people by mobilizing their twin cities. International mobility enables young internationals to become ambassadors for a territory in their country and is an irreplaceable experience in a young person's journey towards social and professional autonomy.

Within this framework, Orleans Metropole and its member municipalities have decided to launch three international work camps in the cities of Orleans, Saint-Cyr-en-Val and Saint Jean de Braye in partnership with the associations Centre Regional d'Information Jeunesse (CRIJ) and Concordia, focused on the preservation and enhancement of the environment.

The CRIJ Centre-Val de Loire is an association that welcomes and informs young people in the region about studies, jobs and employment, housing, health, culture, leisure and mobility. It coordinates the regional Youth Information network which brings together many youth centres and youth workers.

活動内容

Take part in a project to renovate the surrounding wall of the collective vegetable garden in the park of the Castle of La Jonchere, using traditional masonry techniques, in Saint-Cyr-en-Val, a small town between nature and city, located south of the Metropolis of Orleans, in the Loire Valley.

The Castle of La Jonchere and its outbuildings, owned by the municipality, hosts a music school, a library, exhibitions and meeting rooms. It also has a shared vegetable garden in its domain. You will take part in the renovation of the surrounding wall of the park: after having

cleared the Virginia creepers growing on the wall, your work will consist in releasing the stone facade from concrete seals before embellishing it according to traditional techniques respectful of the history of the building - staking, lime repointing, replacement of defective stones.

During the workcamp, you will have the opportunity to meet the gardeners and winemakers whose vines grow near the surrounding wall.

This workcamp is part of a project of three workcamps organized by the Metropolis of Orleans with its member municipalities of Orleans, Saint Cyr en Val and Saint-Jean de Braye and the CRIJ Centre-Val de Loire to help people discover the Loire region and its heritage and cultural wealth. You will have the opportunity to meet and exchange with the volunteers of the Saint-Jean-de-Braye and Orleans workcamps during the welcome drinks, the intercultural day and the itinerant inauguration of the work carried out on the three workcamps.

You will be accommodated under a tent near the multi-activity room of the commune. Please bring your sleeping bag. Sanitary facilities with separate showers and toilets for men and women will be at your disposal. A common room with a fully equipped kitchen will be at your disposal for meals. With the budget allocated to the leader's team, you will participate in the shopping and the preparation of meals, prioritizing healthy and local products. You can bring your own recipes from your countries to share them with the group.

At the crossroads of the Loire Valley, a UNESCO World Heritage site and the wild Sologne, the town of Saint-Cyr-en-Val stretches along the Loire hillside, in a wooded and agricultural environment. It is home to several castles, including the Morchene estate, a municipal property, and the Jonchere castle. The town has a large network of bicycle paths and trails to discover the surrounding area such as the park of Morchene and its collection of irises, the

park of La Motte, or the banks of the Dhuy.

備考

The workcamp will take place in an urban environment, near a wood. For practical and ecological reasons, travel between the place of accommodation and the site will be on foot and by bicycle. It is therefore essential to know how to ride a bicycle.

Remember to bring gloves, clothing and shoes suitable for outdoor work. Don't forget to bring a sleeping bag, summer and rain clothes, a swimsuit and toiletries. You should also take your own sanitary protection equipment: masks and hydro alcoholic gel.

You can bring board games, a musical instrument or any other object you wish to share with the group.
